



Birthday Party Policies

Effective October 19, 2020

Please make sure you read and understand all of these policies before registering for a Birthday party. If you have any questions, please contact us to clarify. Safety is our highest priority at this time. Thank you all very much for your continued support and participation in our programs and for following our new policies to keep everyone safe while being able to play and celebrate together again.

The cost of the birthday party will be \$369 which includes a maximum of 18 children and 32 people total (adults, children and infants are all counted). A non-refundable deposit of \$125 is required at the time of booking. All deposit payments will be made via an invoice which will be sent to your email. You will have 24 hours to pay the deposit to hold your time slot. The balance of the party cost (\$244) will be due the day of the party and will be paid electronically via invoice. Members that are currently enrolled in our classes receive a \$20 discount applied to the balance.

Birthday Parties are for 2 hours only. The first 90 minutes will be in the gym and the last 30 minutes will be in the party room for food and cake. Our staff will set up the food, supply you with the necessary items and prepare the party room for you and your guests, however staff will no longer be staying in the party room with you. You will need to facilitate serving the food and cake to your guests. We will be close by though if you need anything and also to help keep your party on schedule. The gym will be closed and unavailable for your use during the last 30 minutes of the party while you are eating in the party room so that we can clean and disinfect.

Masks are required for all adults and children over the age of 5 at all times during the first 90 minutes of the party. Masks may be removed during the last 30 minutes of the party in the party room while you and your guests are eating but they must be put back on when exiting the party room for any reason. We will have adult and child masks available if anyone forgets theirs.

All guests attending (adults and children) must complete a Comprehensive Waiver of Liability and COVID-19 Certification COVID-19 Certification electronically prior to arrival. The Waiver and COVID-19 Certification for children must be completed by a parent or guardian only. It cannot be completed by another relative or friend. If someone other than the parent/guardian will be bringing your child to the gym, that person must also fill out a COVID-19 Certification for themselves prior to arrival. The party host will receive a link to the waiver which will need to be shared with all guests. These forms only need to be completed one time only, prior to your first visit

The party host must provide the confirmed guest list 2 days prior to the party to us in order to help the check in process go smoothly and quickly the day of the party. We will review the guest list ahead of time to ensure everyone has completed the waiver appropriately.

When guests arrive, they will enter at the front door and wait to be greeted. A staff member will take temperatures and assist with hand sanitizing. If anyone prefers to take their child's temperature themselves with our thermometer, that is fine. Once guests have all three items completed (waiver on file for all attendees, hands sanitized, and temperature below 100.4) they may proceed to the cubby area. We are encouraging people to leave all unnecessary items in your car, but you can leave your keys and shoes or whatever else you bring in with you in your assigned cubby. After you and your child remove your shoes, you may then enter the gym. Please make sure your guests are aware that there are no shoes permitted in the gym and they should be prepared to remove them.

We will be thoroughly cleaning the gym, cubbies, and bathrooms before and after every group uses the gym and will also clean items during activities as needed. The lobby is now closed and our water cooler is no longer available for use. All food and drinks must stay in the party room/kitchen. Guests are not permitted to bring food or drinks into the gym area. Both of our restrooms will be open.
