



Drop n' Prep 2s

Must be 2.5 yrs old by 9/1

Do you have a child that will be starting Preschool soon?

This drop off class will help your toddler get ready for their time away from you and begin to learn in a school-like structure. This class focuses on the emotional and social impact of being dropped off to help ease the transition for you and your child. The class promotes gross and fine motor skill development through crafts, indoor gym time and outdoor play, while also developing listening skills with instructor-led activities and story-time. We also have snack time (snack provided by parents). Children do not need to be fully potty trained, but must be in progress and willing to try to use it everyday. We will help with potty training.



Wednesdays and Fridays

(birthdates between June 2022 and March 2023)

*Note- children with birthdates June 2022 to Sep 2022 can join either class dependent upon developmental status, experience and goals. Feel free to contact us to discuss.

Cost for class is \$360 every 4 weeks. Some months are pro-rated.
 Cost includes one open play for free during each monthly session

If enrolling prior to September 1, a deposit of \$150 is required at the time of registration with the balance of \$210 due on Sep 1. Otherwise, the first full payment is due when registering.

Payments are non-refundable and are due:

There will be no classes Nov 25-28, Dec 23-Jan 5, Feb 17-18, Apr 7-10. Payments do not include these breaks.

- ◆ Pro-rated enrollment after September 1 will be accepted only if room is available in the class. Withdrawals from class are permitted with at least 1 week notice before next payment due date. Missed classes are forfeited, makeup classes are not available and full payment is still required.
- ◆ Enrollment form and current physical signed by physician must be on file prior to attendance.
- ◆ If medication is required to be given to your child while they are with us, a medication authorization form signed by a physician must be on file prior to attendance.
- ◆ Illness Policy: If your child is exhibiting a consistent and productive cough, has a discolored runny nose or has had a fever or has vomited in the prior 24 hours, your child will need to stay home. Credits/refunds cannot be provided for missed classes due to illness.
- ◆ Small class size of 8 children max allows for more individualized attention and support.
